

REPATRIATION

Blacks Law; Repatriation: The regaining of nationality after expatriation, or in the Moors case; naturalization Act of 1870 and the 1880 Treaty of Madrid Article 15 (P) 2.

Expatriation: The voluntary act of abandoning one's country and becoming the citizen or subject of another. The voluntary renunciation or abandonment of nationality allegiance. The Moroccan (Moors) people began establishing tribes or going under the authority of foreign Europeans in order to avoid Moroccan law and taxes, causing an expatriate status for our people.

The process of returning someone or something to their country of origin, citizenship, or allegiance.

Repatriation stems from the Latin word "repatriare," meaning "to return to one's own country." It is the act of sending or bringing someone or something back to their homeland. Example: the return of the Moors (Blacks, Negroes, Coloreds, African Americans, Hebrew Israelites, etc.) to their home country of the Empire of Morocco (not the Kingdom of Morocco, established in 1956).

Repatriation holds significant legal, national, cultural, and economic implications. For individuals it can represent the end of colonization and the restoration of knowledge of jurisdiction and Treaty obligations and the return of lost heritage, financial resources, population and land, air and water resources.

Repatriation understanding means the importance of repatriation is critical to appreciating why its processes are often highly regulated and sensitive.

As an individual you may repatriate to your Empire by petitioning a recognized Moorish government in the territory that you reside in. It is important to note that you must reside in the same territory that has been decolonized by a Moorish government. If there isn't a Moorish government in your territory, then you will need to establish a government to decolonize that territory.

To begin the Repatriation process you must identify a Moorish government in your territory by checking the bottom section of the home page of this website and contact the officials of that government for further instructions. To establish a Moroccan State in your territory which is currently non self-governing, you must have five Moors with at least one female to cover the legislative branch to create a Moroccan State. You will then contact the Wazir Regional Council (WRC) to petition for assistance in this noble endeavor of decolonization at wazirregionalcouncil@gmail.com
